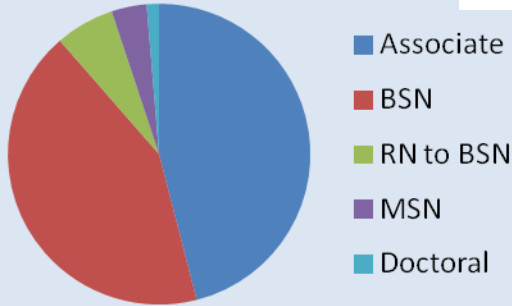

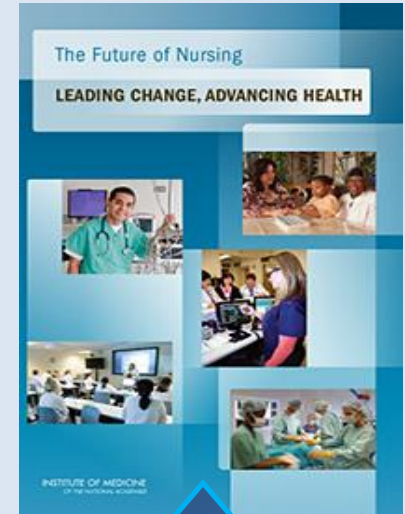
Nurses should practice to the full extent of their education and training.

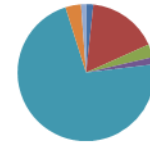
3.7% Hispanic nurses compared to 25-30% overall Hispanic population
